The 24th edition of the ERWL was, like every other aspect of society, over shaddowed by the Covid virus restrictions. Nevertheless 124 walkers registered a performance in the competition and although the amalgmation of real and virtual results over the last five months produced somewhat arbitrary final League tables, the aims of including the virtual races were met.

There is little doubt that even without the restrictions Jacqueline Benson and George Wilkinson would have retained the titles they won 2019 and likewise, that Enfield and Ashford would again dominate the team table. However, anecdotal feedback suggests that it is not prizes, but personal targets, rivalries and cammaradarie that provide the main incentive for participation in the League and race walking in general.

The League's only disapointing aspect is the dearth of young walkers taking part. Of the 124 who did take part only eight were aged under 23 and only three of them seniors. Jacqueline and George the overall winners are two of the country's top juniors and obvuously feel that they benefit from competing in the programme so why aren't there more. Is it because the League is staged under the B rule, is it because it is not over metric distances, is it the travel? If indeed these are the reasons that keeps youngsters away, apart from the latter, some accomodation could be made to overcome them.

The latest Covid news will do nothing to encourage anyone with concerns about meeting and mixing with people and so real racing for some, will remain out of the question. See page 3 for information about the 2022 ERWL and VERWL.
